\*Student should select two (2) of the following during their time Penn Highland to complete the Historical Breadth Course requirements:

- ENG 230 = ENGL 241
- ENG 235 = ENGL 242
- ENG 240 = ENGL 261
- ENG 245 = ENGL 262

Student who complete ENG 250 (WVU ENGL 285) will have completed one (1) of two required Gender/Multicultural/Transnational courses. Students who do not can replace one of the General Electives with a low-level course selection.

\*\*There is no limit to the number of credits students can earn in a subject. However, in Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) programs in the Eberly College, a maximum of forty-two hours in one subject (e.g., BIOL, ENGL, POLS) may be counted toward the minimum hours for graduation. This is equivalent to fourteen courses.

Students will need to select an Area of Emphasis (12-credits) from the below options:

- Creative Writing
- Literary and Cultural Studies
- Professional Writing and Editing (PWE)

To be admitted to the English program, student must have a 2.0 GPA in all ENGL classes taken, and a 2.0 overall GPA. The department will accept students with an overall GPA below a 2.00, if it is the result of low grades outside of the Humanities.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

Students who have questions about admission into their intended program, GEF requirements, or any other issue relating to academics at West Virginia University should contact the Office of Undergraduate Education at WVU.
